- **RES. 2018-29** This is amending 2018 appropriations in Cemetery to pay for the additional 2018 project requests that the Trust is paying for. 1<sup>st</sup> Reading.

**Codified Ordinance Chapter on Solicitors/Peddlers-**

Jenny put together a draft for the Finance Committee to review of how this chapter could be updated. Included is a sample Solicitor permit application. To be continued next month.

**Rental Property Inspections-**

He said there is something out there specifically for hardship cases that he would like to find for situations like this one. He noted that Council has done this previously. After some discussion, the Finance Committee would like to recommend that Council forgives 50% of the sewer portion for that month's bill.
