ORDINANCE 2012-37

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AN EASEMENT FOR STORM SEWER PURPOSES
FROM MICHAEL AND JOAN MCCAULEY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that storm water sewer improvements are necessary between West Franklin and West Prospect Streets in order to more effectively manage storm water within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, an easement is needed from Michael and Joan McCauley in order to install and maintain the necessary infrastructure related to this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that;

SECTION 1: The Council of the Village of Mantua hereby accepts for the purpose of establishing and improving storm water management within the municipality the Permanent Storm Sewer Easement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon passage and execution by Mayor, to enable the Village to begin the contemplated storm sewer project at the earliest possible time in order to complete the necessary work prior to the onset of winter.
