

**Village of Mantua, Ohio
RESOLUTION 2012-51**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE
VILLAGE OF MANTUA TO SOLICIT BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR
PAVING THE ROADS AT THE HILLSIDE CEMETERY, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Portage County Probate Court has approved an expenditure from the Mantua Cemetery Trust for the purpose of paving the cemetery roads; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that bids be received at the earliest possible time so that a contract can be awarded and work can be completed before the onset of winter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator of the Village of Mantua is hereby authorized to solicit bids for paving the roads at the Hillside Cemetery by placing a legal advertisement in the Ravenna-Kent Record Courier on August 24 and 31, 2012, and to enter into a contract for the work indicated with the lowest and best bidder.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were adopted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution be declared an emergency measure, due to the necessity of completing the aforementioned project before danger of winter weather, and shall become immediately effective upon its passage by Council, and to further insure the health, safety and morals of the Village of Mantua.
