ORDINANCE 2013-02

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 2013
APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Crestwood School District will be paying the Village an estimated \$27,000 towards the School Resource Officer, therefore appropriations in the General Fund must be increased by this amount in order to compensate the officer; and

WHEREAS, the Village anticipates collecting \$2000 in 2013 from donations relating to the K-9 Officer program, therefore appropriations in the Police Capital Improvement Fund must be increased by this amount in order to pay expenses relating to the K-9 program; and

WHEREAS, Water Operating Fund 5101 received more income in 2012 than previously anticipated, permitting an increase of \$10,000 in appropriations to that fund, which will be used to pay the Ohio Drilling purchase order for well pump repairs and replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following adjustment to the 2013 Village Appropriations:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to permit payment of the Village's expenses in a timely manner, to avoid permitting expenditures to exceed appropriations and to maintain correct accounting practices, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
