ORDINANCE 2013-106

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 941.14(g) AND AMENDING SECTION 941.14(l) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA, RELATING TO WATER CONSUMED BUT NOT ENTERING THE VILLAGE SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM .

WHEREAS, the Village of Mantua Finance Committee has recommended that reductions in sanitary sewerage charges for water consumed but not entering the Village sanitary sewer system, no longer be permitted for residential customers; and

WHEREAS, Section 941.14(g) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua must be repealed and 941.14(l) thereof must be amended in order to address this recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: Existing section 941.14(g) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Existing section 941.14(l) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Section 941.14(l) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua is hereby enacted as follows:

(l) Water Diverted From Sanitary Sewer. When a commercial or industrial customer can show to the satisfaction of the Village Administrator that a portion of the water as measured by the water meter[s] does not enter the sanitary sewerage system, such commercial or industrial customer may submit in writing an application for the installation of an auxiliary water meter. The Village Administrator has the authority to permit or to require additional meter[s] to be installed at the applicant's expense, so as to measure the quantity of water actually entering the sanitary sewerage system. The quantity of water used to determine the sewerage service charge shall be the quantity of water actually entering the sanitary sewerage system as so determined. The provisions of this section shall not apply to residential customers or to any premises used for residential purposes.

SECTION 4: All other provisions of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua, including the remaining provisions of section 941.14, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by majority vote of the Mantua Village council, at the earliest period allowed by law.
