RESOLUTION 2013-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA'S PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AGREEING TO THE CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (AM. Sub. H.B. No. 100) was signed into law on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the Purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Mantua to request authority in the name of the Village of Mantua to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Mantua to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of the Village of Mantua's participation in the contract. Further, that the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer, on behalf of the Village of Mantua, do hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Mantua are hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Mantua to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Mantua do hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

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SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, in order to permit Village Department Heads to use the state contract rates for any equipment they are purchasing, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
