ORDINANCE 2014-33

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL FUND #1000
TO THE FIRE HYDRANT REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT FUND #4201 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Service Committee has recommended the transfer of \$10,000.00 to the Fire Hydrant Repair and Replacement Fund because the fund currently contains insufficient funds to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following transfer:

FROM	TO	AMOUNT
General Fund #1000	Fire Hydrant Repair and Replacement #4201	\$10,000.00

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to maintain correct accounting practices and to expedite completion of the Fire Hydrant Repair and Replacement project, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
