RESOLUTION 2014-4

**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE STATE
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP), created in 1987 and renewed in 1995 and 2005, and managed by the Ohio Public Works Commission provides opportunity for supplemental funding through grants and loans for all political subdivisions in Ohio (counties, cities, villages, townships, and water and sanitary districts); and

WHEREAS, many essential infrastructure improvement projects, including roads, bridges, culverts, water supply systems, wastewater systems, storm water collection systems, and solid waste disposal facilities, would not be built without this supplemental assistance; and

WHEREAS, these infrastructure improvement projects provide much needed jobs through local contractors; therefore, growing our economy in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Senate has recently passed Senate Joint Resolution 6, which seeks to renew the State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) by placing the issue on the May, 2014 ballot and giving Ohio voters the opportunity to approve \$1.875 billion of investment that will directly benefit local governments and communities.; and

WHEREAS, this Council wished to express its strong support of the State Capital Improvement Program and urge the Ohio House of Representatives to pass the Joint Resolution and permit the issue to be placed on the May, 2014 ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Council of the Village of Mantua, Ohio urges the State of Ohio House of Representatives to pass the Joint Resolution which would place the renewal of the State Capital Improvement Program on the May 2014 statewide ballot for approval by Ohio's voters.

SECTION 2: The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Mantua is hereby authorized and directed to forward a duly signed and attested copy of the foregoing Resolution to the offices of Ohio District 76 Representative Matt Lynch, 77 S. High Street, 13th Floor, Columbus, OH 43215.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure in order that it may be forwarded to State Representative Matt Lynch at the earliest possible time, and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage by this Council.
