RESOLUTION 2016-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Portage County Commissioners, as local administrative agent for Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) funds, is making funds available for various public purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor to submit an application for the CDBG for the purpose of mandatory upgrades to the Village of Mantua dispatch operation center or the paving of East Prospect Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application for Community Development Block Grant funding for improvements to the Village of Mantua.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were adopted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared an emergency measure, in order to permit application for this funding opportunity prior to the application deadline, and shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, and to further ensure the health, safety, and morals of the Village of Mantua.
