ORDINANCE 2016-37

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND #1000 TO THE HEADWATERS TRAIL- MILL ST. CONNECTOR FUND #4908 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Fund 4908 requires an advance in order to pay for the Headwaters Trail-Mill St. Connector project expenses until reimbursements are received from the ODNR Clean Ohio grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following advance:

General Fund #1000	Headwaters Trail Mill St.- Connector Fund #4908	\$75,000.00

SECTION 2. The advance will be repaid upon completion of the project and after the 80% reimbursement of expenses is received from the ODNR Clean Ohio Grant.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to maintain correct accounting practices and to permit the Village to make its semi-annual OWDA and OPWC debt payment when due, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
