ORDINANCE 2016-4

AN ORDINANCE CLARIFYING THE TERMS OF THE THREE CITIZEN MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code section 713.01 requires that a Village Planning Commission shall have three citizen members, each serving six year terms such that one term expires every two years; and

WHEREAS, over the course of decades during which many vacancies on the Planning Commission have occurred and been filled, the original terms of the three citizen members are no longer possible to ascertain; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended clarifying the ending dates of the current terms through legislation so as to eliminate confusion going forward.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1. The expiration dates of the six-year terms of the three current citizen members of the Village of Mantua Planning Commission are as follows:

Wesley Hawkins	December 31, 2017
Robert Gaglione	December 31, 2019
Randy Weaver	December 31, 2021

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage by Council, at the earliest period allowed by law.
