OLD BUSINESS:

- ❖ **Reports-** Overtime, Appropriation Status, Vendors, and SRO handed out. There will be some big expenses in the next few months with the changes in Dispatch. Council is aware. All reports on file.
- ❖ **Dispatch Contracts-** Nothing more at this time from Mantua Fire Dept. Fire Board has indicated they would like more information from Streetsboro reference their quote before making a decision.
- ❖ **Dispatch Equipment-** New equipment has started to come in for Dispatch and is being updated as it arrives.
- ❖ **Phone System** – We have contacted another carrier for a second quote on a phone system for the building, this way we can compare equally. We are also going to get a quote for Fiber Optic Lines to this building and Increase Internet speed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- ❖ **Potato Festival-** Asking for permission for Ride Company personnel to be able to camp in the park with their camping trailers during the festival. Currently our ordinance does not allow this and would take Council's approval. There would be possibly three camper trailers. Security is on the grounds all night. Committee discussed and agreed to move to Council for approval
- ❖ **Handicap Parking** – Hilltop Church is asking for a designated Handicap Parking Spot on Prospect Street in front of the Church. The facility is handicap accessible. Committee discussed and agreed to move forward. Chief will work out details as to exact spot and will contact Service Department for proper marking and signage.
- ❖ **Alarm Box-** Chief discussed with committee the termination of the alarm services in dispatch. Committee agreed that a letter to businesses with a 90 days notification is sufficient.
- ❖ **P/T Dispatch** – We have hired Randi Lyle for Part Time Dispatcher and has started her training. She currently works for the Service Department part time also.

NEW BUSINESS CONT:

- ❖ **Escort** – August 31, 2016 the Snyder family will be leaving Mantua for the “Hero’s Rock-Thank You Tour” to deliver Patriotic Ponies to places where loved ones of military families are receiving medical care. The American Legion has asked for a sendoff from the High School and a Police Escort to the turnpike. The CHS Band will participate with the National Anthem and a 21 Gun Salute will take place at Main & High. Committee discussed and has no issues with the escort.
- ❖ **Garbage/Recycle Pickup** – Trucks coming into Village and starting pickup around 5:30-6:00am. Disrupting families and children while sleeping. Chief ask for Committee and Council to look at specs and set time for no earlier than 7am. If Ordinance is amended the Police Department can enforce it. Committee discussed and agreed.
- ❖ **School** – First day of school is August 15 for freshman and August 16 for all other students. School zone lights will be turned on Friday, August 12.
