RESOLUTION 2011-03

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 2011
APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Mantua has determined that previously appropriated funds must be adjusted in order to continue operations in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council authorized the advance of \$3,000 in 2010 for this project; and at the December 17th, 2010 Council meeting, the Village Council motioned to discontinue this project and return the grant that was awarded; and

WHEREAS, the funds are currently available to advance back to the General Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following adjustment to the 2010 Village Appropriations:
