ORDINANCE 2011-30

AN ORDINANCE RE-DESIGNATING AS PERMANENT TRANSFERS, ADVANCES PREVIOUSLY MADE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FRANKLIN-REGAN STORM SEWER FUND, THE DOWNTOWN MANTUA REVITALIZATION FUND, AND THE CEMETERY FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Franklin-Regan Grant project has been discontinued, and grant monies will not become available to repay the General Fund the total of \$1,690.00 that was advanced in Resolution 2008-51 (\$316.74), Resolution 2009-8 (\$45.36), and Resolution 2009-12 (\$1327.90) for engineering services related to the Franklin Regan Storm Sewer project; and

WHEREAS, The Cemetery fund does not generate enough revenue to repay a \$4,000.00 advance made by Resolution 2010-26 for the purpose of continuing basic operations; and

WHEREAS, The Downtown Revitalization Fund was advanced \$1,000 in order to fulfill a grant obligation by way of Resolution 2009-20, and the fund has since been closed, leaving no possible way to repay the advance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Mantua has determined that these previously advanced funds are incapable of being repaid and should now be re-designated as permanent transfers in order to satisfy the requirements of the Office of the Auditor of the State of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Monies advanced to Fund #4906 in Resolution 2008-51 (\$316.74), Resolution 2009-8 (\$45.36), and Resolution 2009-12 (\$1327.90) are hereby re-designated as permanent transfers.

SECTION 2. \$4,000.00 that was advanced to Cemetery Fund # 2031 in Resolution 2010-26 is hereby re-designated as a permanent transfer.

SECTION 3. \$1,000 advanced to the Downtown Revitalization Fund #2063 in Resolution 2009-20 is hereby re-designated as a permanent transfer.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to satisfy accounting requirements of the Office of the Auditor of the State of Ohio, and shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the

Mantua Village Council, and to further ensure the health, safety, and morals of the Village of Mantua.
