Michele said the deadline to submit for reimbursements relating to the opioid settlement from the four pharmaceutical companies is Friday, August 13th, 2021. We stand to receive between \$2,200 and \$3200. The state is aiming for 95% participation to maximize our recovery. There are provisions written in this legislation that authorized Michele to act as required on the villages behalf so Council does not have to meet every single time as this settlement progresses. Michele said we might be able to pool it for opioid awareness. Michele said fire departments are not eligible and townships are getting next to nothing. Mayor Clark said we might be able to get this money for the fire district if we don't have expenses of our own.
