

SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES
Tuesday October 8, 2024

Kevin called the meeting to order at 6:00pm

Roll Call: Kevin Maloney, Steve Thorn, Chief Urso, Jaime Nosse

Others Present: Miranda Brothers, Bill Mason, Tammy Meyer, Marty Hura

Minutes: Minutes not available

Department Report: Chief presented the Appropriations Status, Vendors and SRO reports.

Citizens: Miranda shared thoughts about why it's hard to find employees. Also noted the disparity between when part-time and full-time people get raises, rooted in a Lexipol policy, where a FT officer (e.g. Miranda) is making less (including OT) than PT dispatchers. Chief pointed the blame to the delay in his review/pay increase. Steve asked for a suggestion from Chief and Miranda for how to resolve the issues.

Old Business:

- Codified 205.09 and 305.10: Discussed proposal to allow parking on-street in paved areas outside the lanes of travel, and where not otherwise posted. Kevin motioned to move legislation to Council; Steve seconded, all ayes.
- Ohio Collaborative: Chief will schedule a meeting with Kevin and representatives to discuss concerns.
- Employee Status: Lost a PT dispatcher, to be replaced with a newly trained dispatcher. One possible officer awaiting an interview. CIT training in progress.
- SRO Position: Awaiting UH to schedule a physical for Tony.
- Building Network Status: AT&T gave us pricing on increasing from 20Mb (\$481) to 100Mb (\$518) or 250Mb (\$797); will bring to Finance for further discussion.

Additional Business:

- Traffic on Main Street: no change
- Vandalism: Cameras are up, but no other activity.
- Special Details: Chief believes that OHSAA requires we have a certain number of officers in attendance at sports.
- Training Updates: Ciko completed annual training. Mayor wants to see training numbers on the monthly numbers spreadsheet.
- Equipment Updates: Old 110K-mile vehicle to be donated to service to use.
- Franklin & Oak Street: Yield sign changed to a Stop; may need to be changed.
- 2FA: LEADS now requires this; users will be using cell phone authentication.

Kevin motioned to adjourn at 6:59pm, seconded by Jamie, all Ayes.
