Chief's Report

- All 5 radios are now 2FA compliant except one spare Kenwood.
- We will likely be losing Marty Toukonen soon due to personal issues.
- Received more SRO applications, currently filtering through candidates. Gilbert/Maroni will be doing the first round of interviews. Brothers will fill in until a candidate is approved by the PD / School.
- We still have 2 dispatchers in training, and 2 more applications in the queue.

New Business:

- Ordinance 375 ATVs - Discussion of changes needed to have our ordinances to comply with recent ORC changes. The committee asked Bill to update 375 legislation, to be reviewed at the next meeting.
- Liquor permits - Joe wanted guidance on the Ohio LCB notice, discussed, no action needed.
- Ordinance 505.09 Barking or Howling Dogs - Joe made suggestions how to handle this scenario.
- Dispatch contract - Long discussion with no definite resolution. Committee agreed to move this to Council for further discussion.

Old Business:

- Traffic Cameras - waiting for vendor representative to call back. When they do, a zoom call will be set up for the September Safety Committee meeting to help answer our questions. Chief will also reach out to 2 local munis for more info.
- Ohio Collaborative - No progress, still working to finish the next group of steps.
