ORDINANCE 2026-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2026-17 AND AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL FUND #1000 TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND #4901, THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND #2021, AND THE PERMISSIVE FUND #2101 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize a one-time transfer in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the General Fund #1000 to the Capital Projects Fund #4901 for the construction of a new salt storage shed for the Village *to support snow and ice control on public streets*; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize a one-time transfer in the amount of \$11,000.00 from General Fund #1000 to the State Highway Fund #2021 for the purchase of road salt; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2026-17 to change The Permissive Fund number to Fund #2101 and authorize a one-time transfer in the amount of \$11,000.00 from the General Fund #1000 to the Permissive Fund #2101 for the purchase of road salt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following one-time transfers:

FROM	TO	AMOUNT
General Fund #1000	Capital Projects Fund #4901	\$30,000.00
General Fund #1000	State Highway Fund #2021	\$11,000.00
General Fund #1000	Permissive Fund #2101	\$11,000.00

SECTION 2. Council hereby authorizes amending the Permissive Fund to account #2101.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to maintain correct accounting practices, to pay the current and imminent financial obligations of the Village and to prevent expenditures from exceeding appropriations, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
