- ❖ **Fireworks Ordinance** – Chief explained Ordinance 1519.04. Chief explains that no matter what the State Law has changed to regarding fireworks, there is still a Local Ordinance stating that no fireworks are to be discharged in the Village. Chief explained that he will post a copy of the Ordinance on the Facebook Page closer to July 4th.
- ❖ **Cemetery LED Lights** – Chief mentioned Ptl Brothers was working some midnight shifts, and noticed that the Cemetery was very dark. Chief mentioned that Ptl Brothers suggested Solar Lights being put up at the Cemetery to add some light during the night. Chief explained that Solar Lights would be the most cost efficient.
- ❖ **Patrol Car Status Update** – Chief explained that he spoke with the sales representative at Tim Lally, and there may possibly be a small window of opportunity to purchase a Patrol Car at the end of this year or the beginning of next year. Chief explained that he put the Department down on the list, not as a commitment, but if the opportunity is lost it could be another year before the Department is able to purchase a vehicle.

- ❖ **Buchert Park Fencing / Signage** – Chief explained about an incident where a vehicle with a handicap placard parked on the grass at Buchert Park near the playground, and after no success of finding the owner, a citation was issued.
