ORDINANCE 2014-13

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 7.5.E OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA
EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK RELATING TO REQUIRED PAGERS FOR VILLAGE
EMPLOYEES.**

WHEREAS, this Council has previously passed Ordinance 2010-24, the Village of Mantua Employee Handbook which contains the Village's policies and guidelines relating to employees; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended that section 7.5.E of the Employee Handbook be repealed, due to the fact that all employees now have cellular telephones and are no longer issued pagers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Existing Section 7.5.E of Ordinance 2010-24 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Ordinance 2010-24, the Village of Mantua Employee Handbook, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage if this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective after passage by at least a majority of the members elected to the Mantua Village Council at the earliest period allowed by law.
