ORDINANCE 2014-50

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 2014
APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the State Highway Fund has experienced above average expenses due to projects related to the S.R. 44 bridge replacement, making it necessary to increase appropriations in the State Highway Fund #2021 in order to satisfy the remaining operating obligations for 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following adjustments to the 2014 Village Appropriations:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to maintain correct accounting practices and to avoid the possibility of expenditures exceeding appropriations, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
