

**Village of Mantua, Ohio
RESOLUTION 2023-09**

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA THE QUESTION OF RENEWAL OF THE 3.85 MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES WITHIN THE VILLAGE, PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTIONS 5705.19(G) AND 5705.191.

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2023, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-04 pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, declaring it necessary to renew the current five year, 3.85 mill road levy, originally approved by the electors of the Village of Mantua on November 4, 2014, and renewed on November 6, 2018, for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the Village which will expire at the end of 2023, and requesting the Portage County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue which would be generated by the renewal of said levy; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2023, the Portage County Auditor certified that the total current tax valuation of the Village is \$24,488,990.00, and that the estimated property tax revenue that would be produced by the renewal of the 3.85 mill levy would be \$80,000.00, assuming that the total current tax valuation of the Village remains the same during the life of the levy, as reflected on “Exhibit A”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, State of Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. This Council finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes that may be raised by the Village of Mantua within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax list and duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of this Village, and that it is necessary to renew an existing property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation, for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the Village pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 5705.19(G).

SECTION 2. Such Renewal Levy shall be for five (5) years and at a rate not to exceed 3.85 mills annually for each One Dollar (\$1.00) of taxable value, which amounts to \$108.00 for each \$100,000.00 of the County Auditor's appraised value, and to be levied on the real property tax duplicate for the whole of the Village of Mantua, Ohio, in excess of the rate authorized by statute.

SECTION 3. The question of the renewal of the 3.85 mill levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, for their approval or rejection, at the General Election to be held on the 7th day of November, 2023 at the regular place of voting in this Village as established by the Board of Elections of Portage County, or otherwise, within the times provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. If approved by a majority of electors voting thereon, such renewal tax levy shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate beginning with the year 2024, the proceeds of

which levy first would be due and collected and made available to the Village in calendar year 2025.

SECTION 5. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Mantua is hereby authorized and directed to give or cause to be given notice of that election as provided by law.

SECTION 6. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, together with Resolution No. 2023-04, adopted February 21, 2023, and the certification of the Portage County Auditor, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", to the Portage County Board of Elections before the close of business on August 9, 2023.

SECTION 7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after proper passage by the Mantua Village Council at the earliest period allowed by law.


Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate
and requests the revenue produced by that rate.

The county auditor of Portage County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

- On February 22, 2023, the taxing authority of the Council of the Village of Mantua (political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted February 21, 2023, requesting the county auditor to certify the current taxable value of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by _____ (3.850) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for purposes pursuant to Revised Code § 5705.19G & 5705.191, to be placed on the ballot at the November 7, 2023, election. The levy type is Renewal.
- The property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the taxable value of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 80,000.00.
- The total taxable value of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ 24,488,990.
- The millage for the requested levy is _____ (3.850) mills per \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$ 108.00 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value.

Instructions

- "Total taxable value" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf. See R.C. 5705.01(A) & (C).
- "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
- "The county auditor's appraised value" means the true value in money of real property. R.C. 5705.01(P).
- For any levy or portion of a levy, an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains throughout the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and if this is not determined, the estimated amount submitted by the auditor to the county budget commission. R.C. 5705.03(B).
- Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
