RESOLUTION 2024-12**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE
AND SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS.**

WHEREAS, the Mantua Village Administrator has identified various opportunities to apply for grant funding for the benefit of the Village; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to grant the Village Administrator general authority to prepare and submit applications for such grant funding in instances where Council approval is not otherwise specifically required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to prepare and submit grant applications on behalf of the Village provided specific Council approval is not required.

SECTION 2. When a grant application requires a commitment of matching funds from the Village or otherwise requires Council approval for its submission, the application must first be authorized by action of Council.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after approval by at least a majority of the members elected to the Mantua Village Council at the earliest time allowed by law.
