ORDINANCE 2024-17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 2024 VILLAGE OF MANTUA APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, appropriations in the General Fund #1000 must be increased in order to pay for operating supplies and materials in Parks, Cemetery, Village Hall and Service, and for replacement of the server for the Police Department's TAC computer, the cost of which was approved by Council on December 19, 2023; and

WHEREAS, appropriations must be increased in funds 2012, 2021, and 2101 in order to pay for the 2024 chip and sealing of village roads; and

WHEREAS, appropriations in the Buchert Park Walking Trail Fund #4201 must be increased in order to refund unused monies from Phase IV to the Downtown Mantua Revitalization Corporation and to pay engineering costs for Phase V; and

WHEREAS, appropriations must be increased in Police Capital Fund #4902 to pay the balance of the purchase price of the new Chevy Tahoe Police vehicle, authorized per Resolution 2023-12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following adjustments to the 2024 Village of Mantua Appropriations:

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to maintain correct accounting practices, to pay the current and imminent financial obligations of the Village and to prevent expenditures from exceeding appropriations, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by Council.
