ORDINANCE 2024-45

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 305.09 AND DELETING SECTION 305.10 OF
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA, RELATING TO
PARKING ON VILLAGE STREETS.**

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by the Safety Committee that Sections 305.09 and 305.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua, relating to Parking on the streets of the Village of Mantua, be amended; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to address this concern by amending Section 305.09 and deleting Section 305.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mantua that:

SECTION 1: Section 305.10 is hereby repealed and Sections 305.09 (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), and (f) are hereby amended and restated as follows:

305.09 PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED PARKING AREAS.

(a) Parking is permitted in the Village on paved surfaces, outside the lanes of travel on streets, except where signs are posted prohibiting parking.

(b) Parking is prohibited on the following streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Main street from North boundary to South boundary
Prospect Street from Second Street to Maple Street
First Street from Prospect Street to Franklin Street

(c) Parking is limited on the following streets or portions of streets to 2 hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.:

East side of Main Street from High Street to Prospect Street
West side of Main Street from Franklin Street to Prospect Street
Prospect Street from Maple Street to First Street

(d) No parking at the Government Center except for government business.

(f) The Village Administrator is hereby directed to install and maintain signs and mark the streets in accordance with the Uniform Traffic Manual as adopted by the Ohio Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2: All other provisions of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this

Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after passage by Council and execution by the Mayor, at the earliest date allowed by law, to preserve the Public health, peace, safety, and welfare within the whole of the Village.
