ORDINANCE 2024-54

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 951.01(b) BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS AND DELETING SECTION 951.01(c) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that Sections 951.01(b) and (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua relating to Board of Park Commissioners of the Village of Mantua be amended; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to amend Section 951.01(b) and delete Section 951.01(c) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mantua, that:

SECTION 1. Section 951.01(c) is hereby repealed and Section 951.01(b) is hereby amended and restated as follows:

951.01 Board of Park Commissioners.

- (b) The Board of Park Commissioners shall be held on a regularly scheduled basis in a room designated at the Village Building. Such meetings shall be open to the public.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after passage by Council and execution by the Mayor, at the earliest date allowed by law, to preserve the Public health, peace, safety, and welfare within the whole of the Village.
